How will Census 2020 data fuel our community's success?

- The 2020 Census will inform tax policies, planning and funding for roads, schools and hospitals, and the redrawing of boundaries.
- Full Census 2020 participation in Colorado will direct more than \$8 billion in federal funding into the state.
- Full Census 2020 participation may result in another Congressional seat in Washington!



CENSUS 2020 IS SAFE!

- The Census Bureau is a statistical agency. Its activities are bound by Title 13 of the U.S. Code, which protects respondents.
- The law protects your information. By law your information is confidential. Your answers cannot be used against you by any government agency or court.
- Census Bureau employees are sworn for life to protect confidentiality -- the penalties for unlawful disclosure are applicable for their lifetime.
