

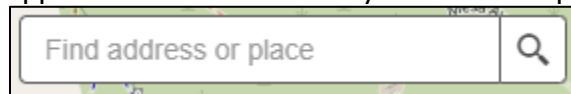


## **Manitou Springs Wildfire Risk Portal:** *Site Assessment Web Map Instructions*

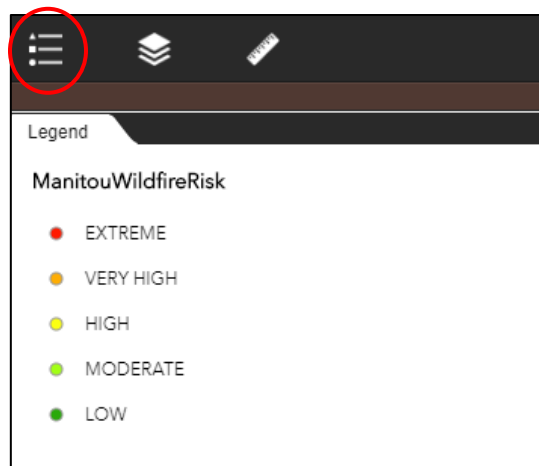
1. There are two (2) options for locating a particular property on the Wildfire Risk Portal Web Map:
  - a. If the geographic location is known visually on the map, one can simply zoom in on a specific property using the mouse and the + or – buttons located in the upper left corner of the application.



- b. If the address of the property is known, one can type in that address into the “Find address or place” search field, also located in the upper left corner of the application, click the Magnifying Glass icon or hit the Enter key, and the application will automatically zoom the map frame in on that location.

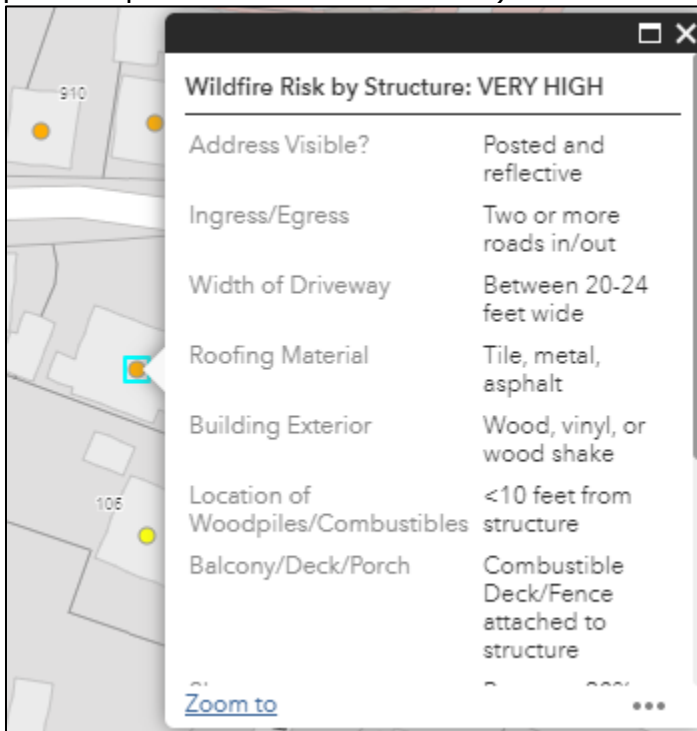


2. Each parcel or property in which there is a building will have a color coded dot that represents that property’s risk for a wildfire event. The map legend, which depicts the various dot color meanings and representations, can be located on the left side of the map.





- Once zoomed in on a location, one can click on the colored dot for a given property/structure to see how it was assessed and evaluated for wildfire risk. A pop-up containing information and data regarding the assessment will appear. To better understand how a given property is scored and assessed, one will want to reference the **Wildfire Risk Mitigation Assessment Tool** (Click on the link here to access a printable pdf version of this document).



- Various map layers may also be toggled on and off using the Layers widget Located in the left hand corner of the application. There is also a Measurement tool widget found in the same location.
