## Emergency Order Concerning the Use of Face Coverings Has Been Lifted

MANITOU SPRINGS CO – The City of Manitou Springs has lifted its Emergency Order Concerning the Use of Face Coverings. Therefore, face coverings are no longer required within all public indoor places. This order was lifted with unanimous approval by Manitou Springs City Council during their Special Meeting on February 8<sup>th</sup>.

We are still strongly encouraging the use of face coverings in public spaces and urging our residents and visitors to become fully vaccinated against COVID-19. The decision to require face coverings continues to be available to our individual businesses, and we are strongly urging our residents and visitors to respect their rules and guidelines.
