City of Manitou Springs Cancels its April 12th City Council Meeting Due to Officer Involved Shooting Incident

MANITOU SPRINGS CO – Very rarely does the Manitou Springs community experience tragedies and incidents like the one that happened on Monday night. It is during hard times like these, that our community and staff need time to come together and process the recent loss of an El Paso County Sheriff’s Office K9 during an Officer Involved Shooting in Manitou Springs.

The Manitou Springs City Council will be cancelling their April 12th Work Session to allow the Manitou Springs’ community time to grieve with this recent tragedy.

“It was with extreme sadness that the Manitou Springs City Council learned about this.” said John Graham, Mayor of Manitou Springs. He continued “In addition to our police, we have had many city staffers working through the night to support this incident. In order to give them, and our community, time to regroup emotionally, we will cancel tonight’s City Council meeting.”
