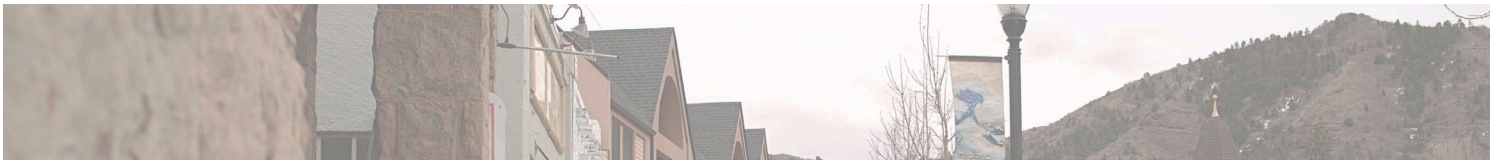

Multiple Wood Chipping/Disposal Events Coming to Manitou Springs

MANITOU SPRINGS CO – To help the Manitou Springs community clear out their property of fallen trees and tree branches, the City of Manitou Springs will be hosting three opportunities for wood disposal. The dates are as follows:

Note for the Chipper Days: tree limbs can be any length but must be less than 4 inches in diameter. Shrubs are allowed if the root ball has been removed. No construction materials, bags of leaves, grass clippings, or other waste is allowed. DO NOT move your tree limbs to the public right-of-way expecting our crews to service them. They will not.

In addition, starting mid-June we will be launching a pilot program for mobilizing our woodchipper to every neighborhood in Manitou Springs! Stay tuned for more information regarding how to participate!
