UPDATED DATES: Paving Operations Coming to Duncan, Michigan, and Mesa Ave. from July 25 – July 29

MANITOU SPRINGS CO – Due to an issue with equipment availability, the paving and milling construction scheduled for Duncan, Michigan, and Mesa Ave. will be postponed one-week. Therefore, the new roadways coming to Duncan, Michigan, and Mesa Avenues will be constructed on the week of July 25th, with work tentatively ending on July 29th. During this construction period, no parking on the roadway will be allowed so please park in valid parking spaces on the side streets not being paved. In order to make this process easier, the work will be phased as follows:

July 25 & July 26 – Milling and paving on Duncan

July 26 & July 27 – Milling and paving on Michigan

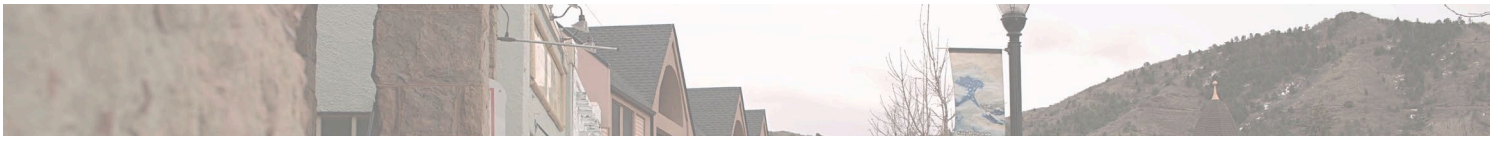
July 27 - July 29 – Milling and paving on Mesa

Construction will take place from 7AM-7PM throughout the week, so please drive safely through the area as crews will be working in the street. One-way through traffic and access to homes will be maintained as much as possible throughout the project, but there may be periodic closures in order to complete the work.
