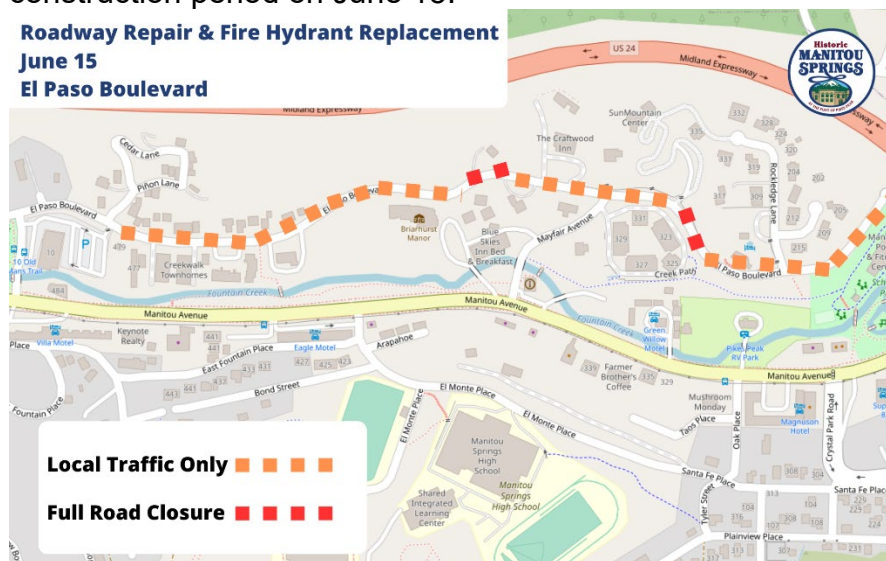
Road Closure on El Paso Boulevard Extended for Fire Hydrant Repair

MANITOU SPRINGS CO – The City of Manitou Springs’ Public Works department will be extending the June 15 closure on El Paso Boulevard from Garden of the Gods Place to the Hiawatha Gardens parking lot in order to minimize future construction impacts and road closures on El Paso Boulevard. The closure will be in effect from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. during this day.

This extended closure will allow the City’s public works department to fix a small portion of sinking roadway and repair a malfunctioning fire hydrant simultaneously.

It is important to note that residents residing within the affected stretch of roadway will still have access to their homes throughout the construction period. However, unless you live in the area, we kindly request that you avoid El Paso Boulevard during the construction period on June 15.

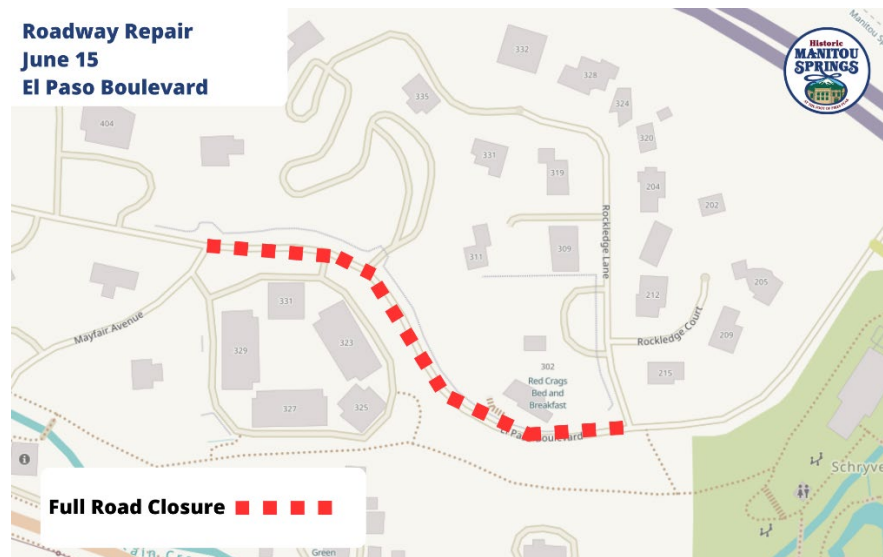
Road Closure Scheduled to Repair Roadway on El Paso Boulevard

MANITOU SPRINGS CO – Our Public Works Department will be repairing a sinking piece of roadway on El Paso Boulevard on Thursday, June 15. To facilitate the repair process, a temporary closure of El Paso Boulevard, from Mayfair Ave. to Rockledge Ln., has been scheduled for June 15. The closure will be in effect from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. during this day.

During the closure, we have established detour routes for eastbound and westbound traffic. Eastbound traffic will be directed to take Mayfair Ave. to Manitou Ave. as an alternative route, while westbound traffic will be redirected via Garden of the Gods Pl. to Manitou Ave.

It is important to note that residents residing within the affected stretch of roadway will still have access to their homes throughout the construction period. However, we kindly request that no through traffic is attempted within the closed section.

We value your understanding and cooperation as we strive to improve our roadways and provide a safe and reliable transportation infrastructure for our community.
